IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THESE COURSES

1 – 2012/2013 is the last year that UKCC1, UKCC2, Club Coach (including Coach Development Workshops), Working in Schools and Young Leader courses will be run in their current format.

The ECB will be introducing new courses due to start from September 2013. Currently we are unsure what these will look like or consist but the whole Coach Education structure will change.

2 - All 6 Coach Development Workshops MUST be taken before the Club Coach Award. These workshops will not be available again after April 2012

3 - All candidates MUST supply an email address on booking a course. All correspondence will be by email and the website and not by post

4 - Candidates must be 16 years of age to enrol on a UKCC1 course and 18 years of age to enrol on a UKCC2 course.

5 - All candidates must attend the SPC and First Aid components of their course as advertised unless they already have up-to-date certificates. Certification cannot take place without attendance at these courses.

An ECB Vetting Check is also required in order to be certificated. Candidates must clearly indicate the dates that these courses were taken on their application form and the same applies for their Vetting Check. NOTE: 'Up-to-date' = within the past 3 years and must not expire during or within the 3 months following completion of the course.

6 - For all UKCC2 courses a £50 charge will be made to any candidate that is unable to make his/her original assessment date or who fails their initial assessment and requires a new assessment date or reassessment

7 - There are 28 places available on all coaching courses. SPC and First Aid courses are limited to 20 places per course

8 - Places on courses can only be booked if full payment is received by the KCB at the time of booking on a course.

9 - If candidates sign the direct debit form for joining the ECB CA (cost £25 annually) they can save £10 on the course cost by getting it at a reduced rate. This applies for UKCC1, UKCC2 2 and the Club Coach Award

10 - Coaches operating in the Metropolitan area can access up to 75% funding via the Lord Mayor's Fund for UKCC1 and UKCC2 courses by carrying out up to 25 hours voluntary coaching in their club.
