PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO

Parents, Carers and Guardians will want to celebrate the achievements of their children when taking part in sporting activities organised by Kent Cricket Board (KCB) by taking photographs and videoing their children in action. Equally, Kent Cricket Board wants to promote our activities and to illustrate the joy and pleasure that participation in Cricket can bring and photos and videos are extremely helpful in doing that.

However, we must also be mindful of the risks that are posed directly and indirectly to children through the use of photographs of them taking part in events organised by us.

Also, some Parents, Carers and Guardians may not wish for their children to be included in any photograph or video and we understand and respect their decision. We need to be as sure as we can be that your wishes are followed.

Our commitment

Kent Cricket Board will endeavour to inform you and all our young Cricketers if a photographer or the media will be at the event, recognising though that often we are not informed until it happens. If we publish any photographs ourselves, then we will not publish at the same time the names of any of the players in the photograph.

We will not knowingly permit photographs, video or other images of the young People who play Cricket with Kent Cricket Board to be taken without consent. If you feel photos or video is being taken without that consent, please advise the Coach or administrator immediately.

In order to be clear about what photography and video is allowed by you, and for KCB to keep to those wishes, we need you to complete this form and return it to us on the first occasion your child or children attend. **Please note we will need Consent Forms for all individuals under the age of 18.**

KCB is often asked by other cricketing organisations, particularly Kent County Cricket Club and the England and Wales Cricket Board, to use photos that we have published on our website.
